

## DEBRIS DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING GUIDE

- **TRASH BINS:** Trash bins must be ordered from the City of Encinitas' solid waste franchisee, EDCO Waste and Recycling Services, (760) 436-4151.
- **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:** To meet the needs of our residents, several options are provided for the proper disposal and recycling of household hazardous waste. These include door-to-door home collection (by appointment) and permanent collection facilities located in the cities of Vista ([1145 E. Taylor Street](#)) and Poway ([12325 Crosthwaite Circle](#)). The permanent facilities are open on Saturdays from 9am to 3pm (closed holiday weekends). Proof of residency (formal ID or utility bill with Encinitas address) is required. Call (858) 481-SAFE (7233) for additional information.
- **DEMOLITION:** A Demolition Permit is required for removal of debris such as structures, walls, foundation, pool, etc. Cleanup and removal of other debris generally does not require a permit. Permit and building information is available from Development Services, at the Planning Counter at the North end of City Hall, (760) 633-2710.
- **CONTRACTORS:** The City of Encinitas does not endorse nor recommend contractors. The status of a contractor's license is available from the Contractors State License Board [www.clsb.ca.gov](http://www.clsb.ca.gov). The CSLB recommends checking the type and status of a license to avoid being the victim of an unlicensed contractor. #### **Carlsbad/Palomar Transfer Station**

Location: 5960 El Camino Real, Carlsbad, CA 92008

Hours: M-F, 9am-4pm; Saturday and Sunday, 7:30am - 4pm

Accepted: Mixed loads of debris including concrete and other recyclable material, which is sorted by staff.

Be sure to call ahead to make sure they accept the items you need to recycle. You should also contact them to inquire about any fees.

### **EDCO Construction, Demolition and Inert (CDI) Recycling Facility - San Marcos**

Location: 224 S. Las Posas Road, San Marcos, CA 92078

Hours: M-F, 8am-4pm; Saturday and Sunday, 8am-3pm (Closed daily 12-12:30pm)

Telephone: (760) 744-2700 (inland); (760) 436-4151 (coastal)

Accepted: Wood, metals, rock, dirt, concrete, asphalt, drywall, and cardboard, which is separated by staff

Not accepted: Hazardous waste, garbage, painted or treated wood or yard waste

Note: Contact first for disposal information and fees.

### **Hanson Aggregates**

Location: 9229 Harris Plant Road, San Diego, CA 92163

Hours: M-F, 7am-3:45pm; Saturday 7am-3:15pm

Telephone: (858) 715-5600

Accepted: Clean concrete with rebar cut flush and asphalt. Material must be no larger than 24" on each side

Not accepted: Excessive rebar/wire, fabric, brick, ash, dirt, grass, trash, fluids, non-inert and hazardous materials

Note: Materials not meeting requirements may be subject to higher fees or being turned away

Hanson will accept four free loads of clean concrete/asphalt per home site from fire victims. Your truck driver must give them your address when making the delivery. The company will have a list of the fire-destroyed addresses from the City of Encinitas. They accept only clean concrete and asphalt, it can be mixed together, with pieces no larger than 2 x 2 feet.
