PUBLIC NOTICE OF ORDINANCE ADOPTION
ORDINANCE NO. 2016-08**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Encinitas has adopted Ordinance No. 2016-08 entitled, “An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Encinitas, California, adopting amendments to Title 2 (Administration) and Title 30 (Zoning) of the Encinitas Municipal Code to add Chapter 30.33 (Urban Agriculture) and other amendments; and amendments to the Cardiff-by-the-Sea, Downtown Encinitas, Encinitas Ranch and North 101 Corridor Specific Plans to make reference to Chapter 30.33 of the Encinitas Municipal Code.” This ordinance establishes a system for urban agriculture throughout the City of Encinitas by encouraging small-scale urban agriculture activities such as, but not limited to, community gardens, farmers’ markets, temporary food stands, and beekeeping. In addition, the ordinance establishes a new Agriculture Permit process specific to urban agriculture activities. Ordinance 2016-08 was introduced at the Regular City Council meeting held on May 11, 2016 and **adopted** at the May 25, 2016 Regular City Council meeting by the following vote: AYES: Blakespear, Kranz, Shaffer; NAYS: Gaspar, Muir; ABSTAIN: None. ABSENT: None. The ordinance is on file in the office of the City Clerk, 505 South Vulcan Avenue and may be viewed between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.
